MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Like so many young girls, my daughter wanted to ride horses. We found a trainer who was willing to teach her about the "art of riding".

The trainer assured us that she had some horses on her property that were perfect for the inexperienced riders. She enthusiastically started her lessons.

I asked her about the horses and her riding. It was explained that the trainer insists that no one can presume to get on a horse without first learning certain "ins and outs" of the equestrian experience.

For weeks, my daughter learned about brushing the mane and body of the horse, how to clean the hooves, the feeding regimen, how to approach a horse, how to lead the horse for a walk around the corral... and much more before being able to get up onto the horse. Mainly, my daughter learned how to "muck a stall". "Mucking" is the task that would presumably fall to the person on the lowest of the social scale on a ranch. "Mucking" is the task to address the manure and soiled bedding in the barns. "Mucking" is the task that is not part of a "polite society". "Mucking" is done "behind the scenes" without fanfare.

A case can be made that the faithful among us must attend to "mucking" before the ultimate goal of a divinely inspired life. Some of the expectations of a faithful life is "dirty and stinky". Some of the tasks are those no one else wants to do.

The challenge is that "mucking" is not an imposition or punishment. "Mucking" is serving others, especially those whose "stalls" of life have gotten oppressive by neglect.

We have been commissioned to do the presumed "unpleasant" ... and to do this with JOY, SONG, AND PRAISE for the opportunity.

Ylvisaker, who at that time was the pastor of Our Savior's Lutheran Church, in Lafayette, California. He explained that "Mt" was for the terrain of the property and the "Cross" was derived from "Santa Cruz" meaning Holy Cross.
